

5-year spending trend (2009 through 2014)

Total spending per pupil decreased by 25 percent. Spending in the classroom varied year to year, increasing overall from 62.1 to 65.4 percent. Spending on most nonclassroom areas also varied year to year, as is common for very small districts. Overall, spending on instruction support decreased substantially and spending on administration and student support decreased.




Total operational and instructional spending per student




Changes in operational spending percentages




