



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,336 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district performance.
- The number of students meeting or exceeding AIMS test reading, language, and math standards increased by an average of 6 percent.
- The District accomplished its goal of 90 percent participation of parents at parent/teacher conferences.
