



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, and counselor earned an additional \$4,644 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Goals were linked to student achievement, teacher development, and leadership activities.
- Teachers participated in AIMS intervention as well as district and school-wide committees.
- Teacher development included planning and developing curriculum maps and attending workshops or university classes.
