






#### 5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 26 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, increasing overall from 33 to 35.8 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, all nonclassroom areas also varied year to year, as is common for very small districts.


#### Administrative cost per student



# Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)




# Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student




