## Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional $\$ 2,546$ in salary, and the counselor earned an additional \$1,600.


## Performance

- The District accomplished its performance goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Student achievement on standardized tests improved at each school, on average.
- Student attendance of 94.5 percent was maintained.
