

Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional \$2,546 in salary, and the counselor earned an additional \$1,600.

Performance

- The District accomplished its performance goals, which were based on school and individual performance.

- Student attendance of 94.5 percent was maintained.
- Teachers participated in professional development activities, and most met the 97 percent attendance goal.
