

Total spending per pupil decreased by 3 percent. Spending in the classroom varied year to year, decreasing from 55.8 to 52.7 percent. Overall, spending on student support increased substantially, spending on food service and instruction support increased, and spending on transportation increased slightly. Spending on administration and plant operations decreased.








### Administrative cost per student




# Total operational and instructional spending per student




## Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student




