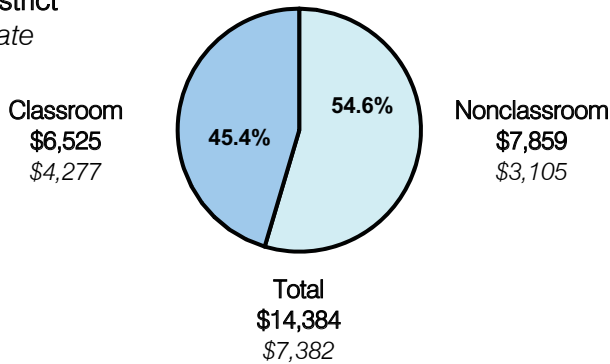

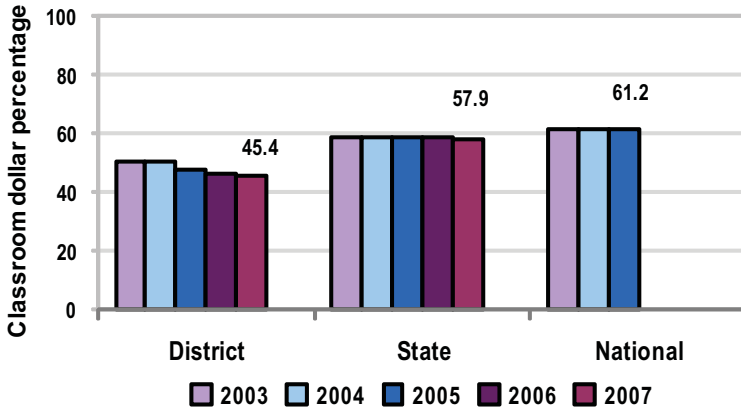

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2007 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,076 in salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished all of its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- The school was labeled "Performing Plus" by ADE for AZ LEARNS.
- Teachers received satisfactory performance evaluations.
- For the teacher development goal, teachers' weekly lesson plans were evaluated and teachers were observed in the classroom by peers and administrators.

##### Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase teacher compensation.
