



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned \$3,765 in additional salary, and each counselor earned an additional \$2,369.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district and school performance.
- Students' AIMS test scores in reading, writing, and math increased.
- Teachers participated in at least 64 hours of professional development activities as well as curriculum development.

Menu

- The District continued to use monies to pay 9 kindergarten through 8th-grade teachers to reduce class sizes.
- Monies were also used to pay relocation stipends and to further compensate teachers for improved student achievement.
