

Total spending per pupil decreased by 1 percent. Spending in the classroom was very inconsistent year to year, decreasing overall from 54.9 to 54.1 percent. Overall, spending on plant operations and transportation increased and spending on student support increased slightly, while spending on administration decreased.










## Total operational and instructional spending per student




## Changes in operational spending percentages




# Average teacher salary




# Administrative cost per student
