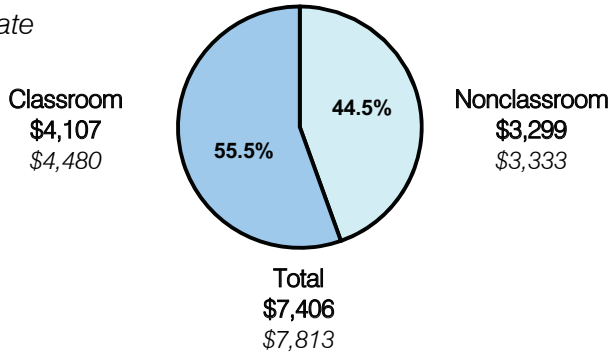

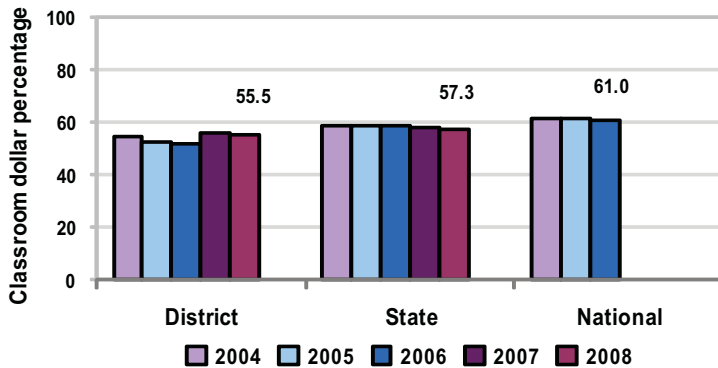

District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, counselor, and teacher mentor earned between \$6,105 and \$7,653 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Students' scores on pre- and post-tests of a state standard or competency increased by at least 50 percent.
- Each teacher completed 15 hours of professional development activities to obtain full Structured English Immersion endorsement.
- Teachers attended a writing in-service training.

Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- The District continued to pay a small stipend to 3 employees for monitoring the Classroom Site Fund program.
