## District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional $\$ 3,300$ in salary, and each social worker earned an additional \$900.


## Performance

- Most schools accomplished their goals. Each school was given 2 years to accomplish 1 of 4 possible goals, which include student achievement on standardized tests and $A D E$ ratings for $A Z$ LEARNS. For schools that did not accomplish at least 1 of the goals this year, monies will be set aside and paid to teachers next year if the goal is met at that time.


## Menu

- Most monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Approximately 4,400 students were involved in AIMS intervention programs to improve reading skills.
- Approximately 1,8008 th-grade students received additional tutoring in preparation for high school.
- Teachers attended trainings focused on improving students' reading and math skills.
