

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



5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 6 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom decreased from 52.4 to 50.1 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, administration and food service increased, while most other nonclassroom areas remained stable.


Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)




Changes in operational spending percentages




