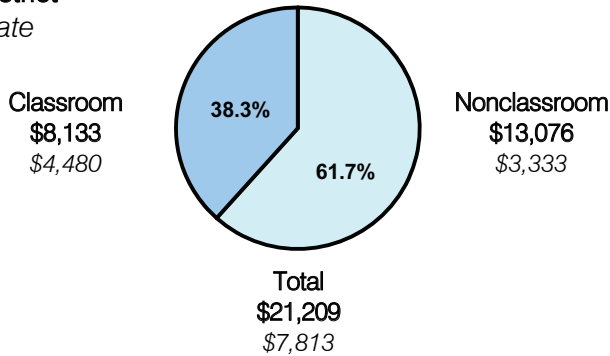

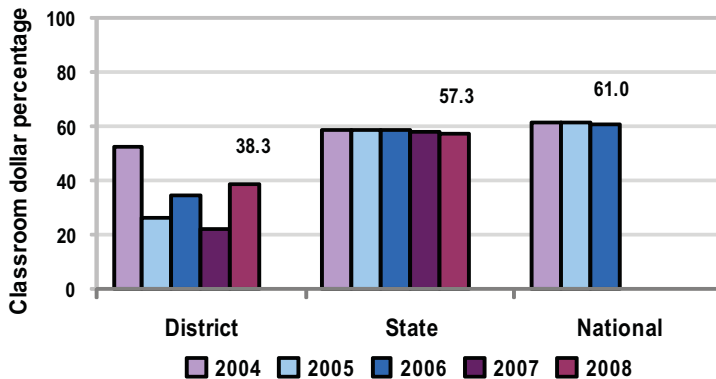

District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,123 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Teachers succeeded in achieving at least 22 of 25 criteria of the District's quality program, including developing lesson plans that ensure all related academic skills are taught and student proficiency is documented, using district-approved course syllabi, and ensuring that students participate in a student satisfaction survey on an annual basis.
- All parents responding to a survey reported satisfaction with the District.
