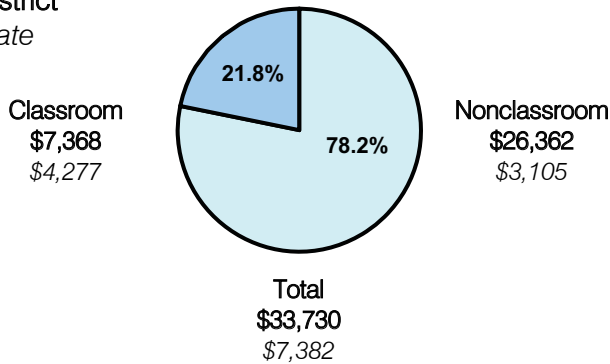

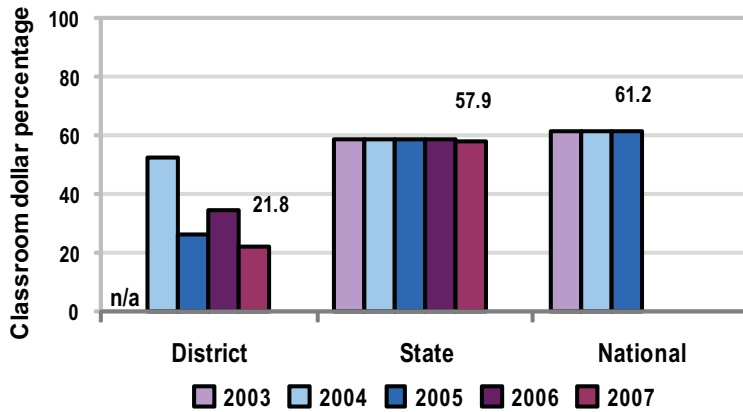

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$6,599 in salary, which includes performance pay for fiscal year 2006 performance.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and school performance.
- Student achievement goals were based on students' scores on standardized skills tests.
- At least 90 percent of parents responding to a survey reported satisfaction with the District.

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase teacher compensation.
- Monies were also used to pay for conference registrations.
