

Total spending per pupil returned to 2009 levels, but spending in the classroom decreased from 57.2 to 50.6 percent. Spending on plant operations and student support increased substantially and spending on instruction support increased. Spending on most other nonclassroom areas varied year to year.




### Students attending




### Total operational and instructional spending per student




### Changes in operational spending percentages






