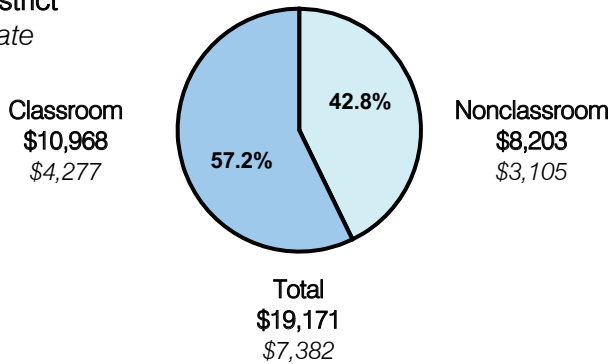

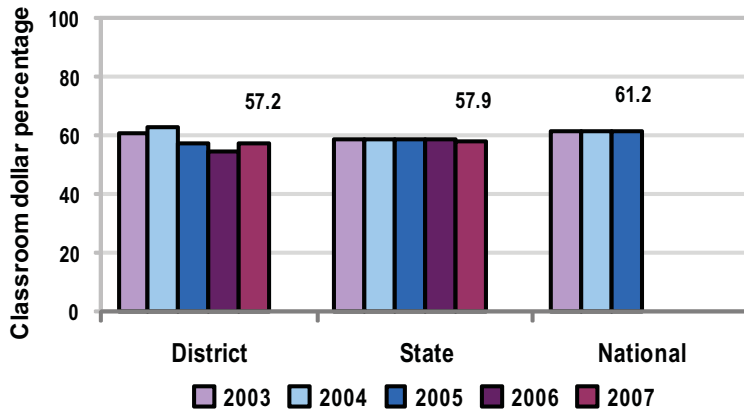

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,834 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district performance.
- 50 percent of students demonstrated 1 year's academic growth.
- Of the parents and students responding to a survey, 50 percent were satisfied with the District.

Menu

- Teachers were compensated for extra duties and work completed before or after the official workday.
- Teachers were also compensated for attending workshops and training on science and reading and for providing training for district staff on reading comprehension strategies and student advocacy.
