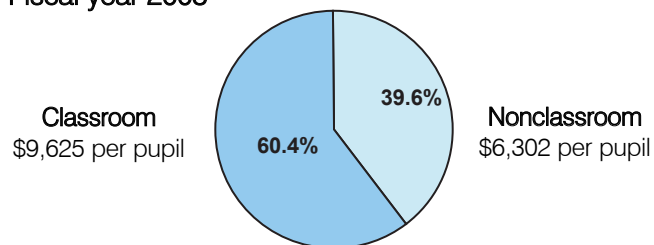

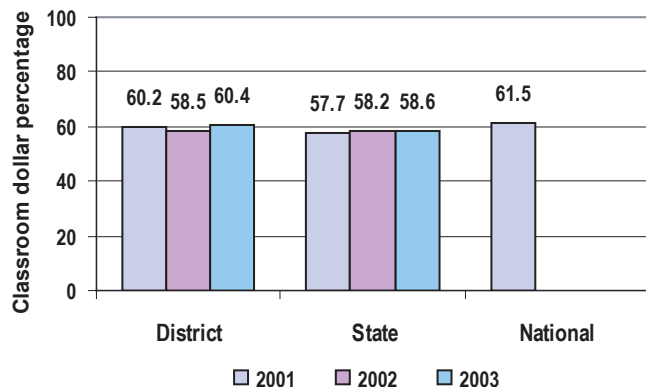
Classroom Dollars

District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and instructional aide earned an additional \$250 in salary.
- Monies were also used to provide \$250 salary increases to non-teaching staff, including the Superintendent, cafeteria manager, bus drivers, custodial and maintenance workers, and others. The District indicated that these other staff interact with students and model behaviors.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district performance.
- The school achieved a "maintaining" rating by ADE for AZ LEARNS and met adequate yearly progress goals.
- Students' reading scores increased and all kindergarten students were reading.
- Teachers participated in professional development and leadership activities.

Menu

- Monies were used for AIMS Intervention activities including aligning curriculum to state standards, which the District indicated resulted in higher test scores.
