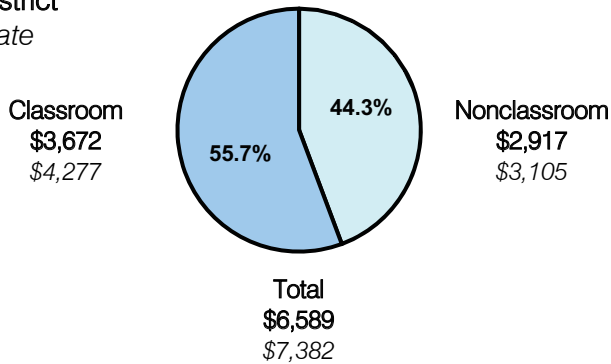

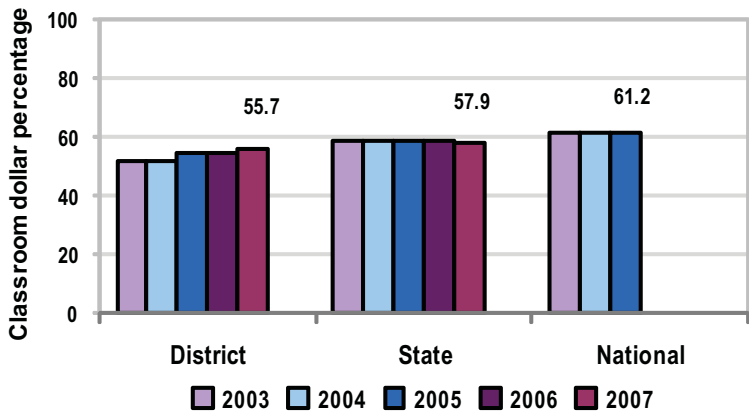

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2007 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, and counselor earned an additional \$3,901 in salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished some of its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- The District accomplished its student achievement goals which required 95 percent of students to participate in state standardized testing, and for teachers to develop a school improvement plan and curriculum mapping.
- The goals not met were linked to parent satisfaction and teacher development.

##### Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
