

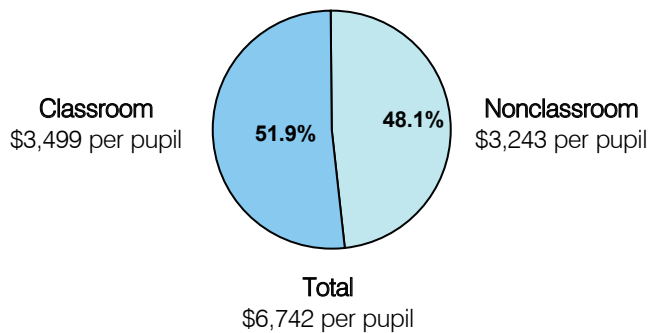

Fiscal year 2004

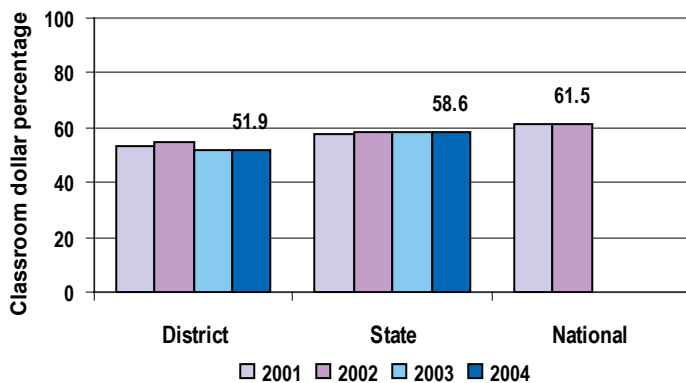

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2004 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, counselor, and curriculum coach earned between \$2,710 and \$3,080 in additional salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district-wide performance.
- Students, on average, demonstrated a 6 percent increase in combined reading, writing, and math scores on the AIMS test.
- Other goals were linked to teacher attendance.

##### Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Additionally, the District continued to use monies to pay for curriculum planning, mini-assessment development, and summer- and recovery-school programs.
