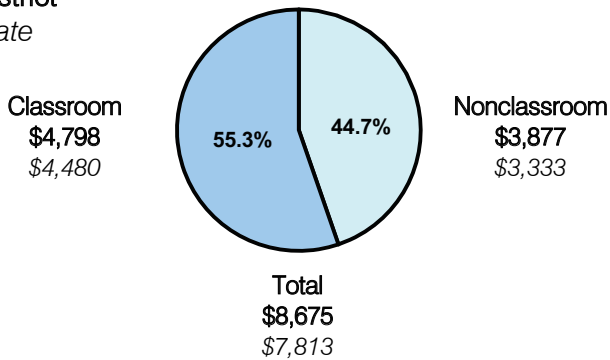

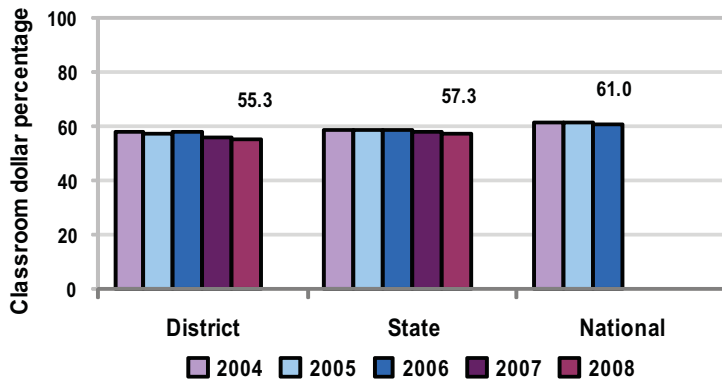

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned \$4,950 in additional salary, and each counselor earned \$3,417.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- High school teachers submitted weekly lesson plans and implemented advanced education interventions in reading, math, and writing.
- Junior high school teachers taught essay question competencies and integrated math concepts in all subjects.
- Kindergarten through 3rd-grade teachers wrote lesson plans that addressed students' reading, writing, math, and science needs.
