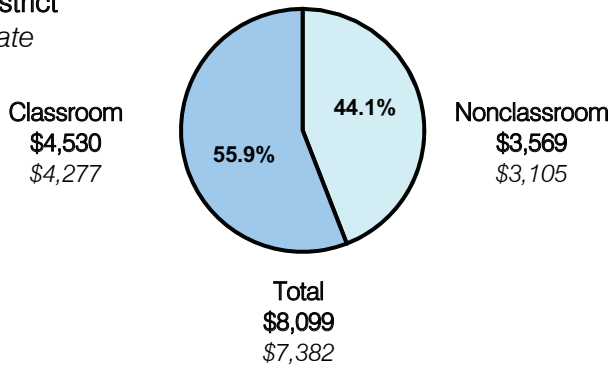

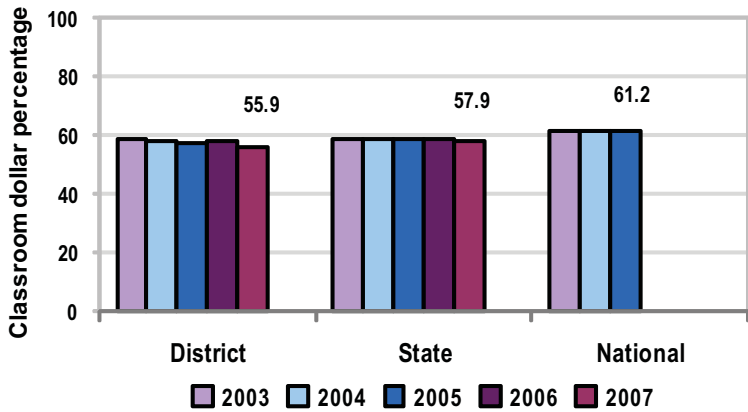

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,125 in salary, each counselor earned \$2,049, and each audiologist earned \$1,366 in additional pay.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- High school students successfully completed weekly tasks in vocabulary, math, and writing. Tasks were measured for accuracy and understanding.
- The implementation of a discipline plan significantly reduced the number of discipline problems.
- Teachers aligned 4th- through 6th-grade science curriculum and 7th- through 8th-grade writing curriculum to match state standards, and received satisfactory performance evaluations.
