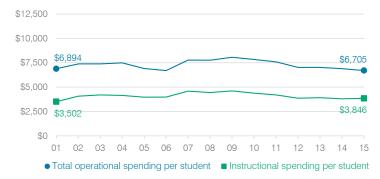

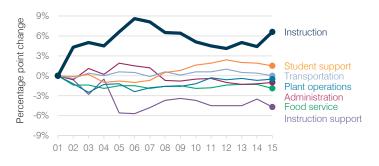
5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 15 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, increasing overall from 55.9 to 57.4 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, instruction support decreased and transportation decreased slightly. Plant operations increased slightly, while other nonclassroom areas remained fairly stable.

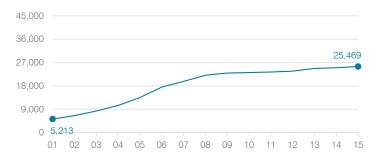
Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)



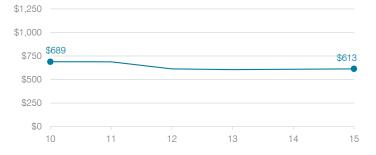
Changes in operational spending percentages



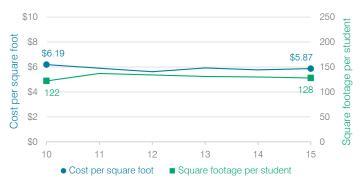

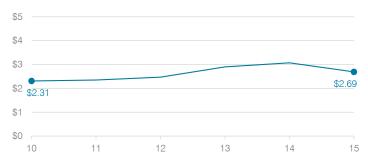
Administrative cost per student
