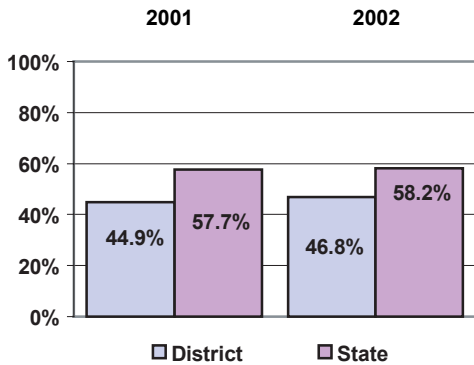

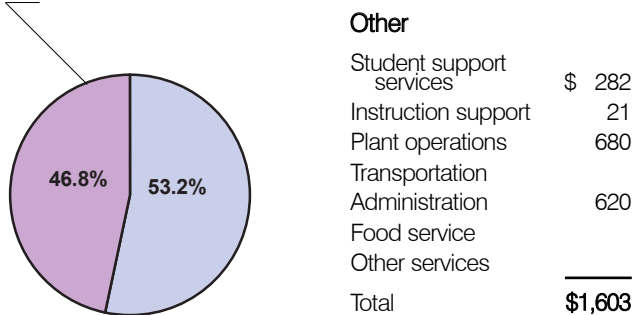

Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.73 percent of the District's \$8,374,406 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned between \$2,751 and \$4,756 in additional compensation.
- 360 graduating students were placed in jobs.
- 7 teacher's aides were hired to provide individualized help to students. 1 aide works with the automotive program to assist students and to monitor those placed in internships with area automotive dealerships. Another works with students in the District's video program, and the remaining aides assist students who are having difficulty in classes.
