



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned \$4,890 in additional salary, and each instructional aide earned an additional \$500.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- Students had to improve their standardized test scores over the prior year's in 2 categories.
- The District scored a grade of "B" or higher on parent satisfaction surveys.

Menu

- Teachers held documented conferences with 95 percent of parents during the first 2 weeks of school.
- Teachers also earned additional compensation for after-school tutoring for AIMS intervention and professional development activities.
