

### 5-year spending trend (2009 through 2014)

Total spending per pupil increased by 7 percent. Spending in the classroom decreased from 50.7 to 43.9 percent. Overall, spending on instruction support increased substantially, spending on administration and transportation increased, and spending on plant operations increased slightly. Spending on other nonclassroom areas varied year to year.








### Administrative cost per student




# Total operational and instructional spending per student




# Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student




#### Changes in operational spending percentages
