

Proposition 301 expenditures were 5.86 percent of the District's \$233,213 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned between \$2,475 and \$3,325 in additional compensation.
- 4 teachers accomplished performance goals that involved performance evaluations, student and teacher attendance, developing student assessments, and testing.
- Student attendance was 88 percent, which exceeded the goal.
- 34 students participated in career exploration counseling and character education programs.
- At least 75 percent of teachers completed individual professional-development plans.
