



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional \$3,709 in salary, and the counselor earned an additional \$3,827.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Goals were linked to students' reading and math scores on standardized tests, and to teacher participation in leadership activities such as mentoring and committee work.
- About 60 percent of students, on average, increased their reading and math scores on standardized tests.
- Schools documented efforts to increase parent participation.
- Teachers documented efforts to integrate technology into the classroom.

Menu

- Monies continued to be used for AIMS intervention activities, including new teacher orientation, after-school tutoring, and intersession classes.
- Monies were also used to increase eligible employee compensation.
