District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher, counselor, librarian, and speech therapist earned an additional $\$ 2,816$ in compensation.
- 78 teachers, 3 counselors, 2 librarians, and 5 speech therapists accomplished performance goals, which involved receiving at least a 75 percent satisfaction rating on a parent survey.
- Teacher retention improved as a result of salary increases.
- Monies were also used for teacher development activities.
