





5-year spending trend (2011 through 2016)


Administrative cost per pupil

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, returned to 2011 levels. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, increasing overall from 45.5 to 46.6 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, instruction support decreased substantially, while plant operations increased substantially and administration increased slightly. Other nonclassroom areas varied year to year.

Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2016 dollars)





Changes in operational spending percentages










Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student
