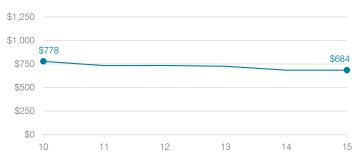

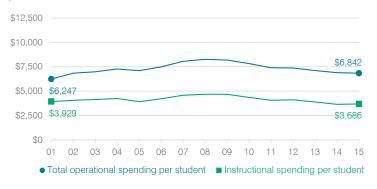
#### 5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 13 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, decreasing overall from 55.6 to 53.9 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, student support increased substantially and food service increased slightly, while administration and plant operations decreased slightly.

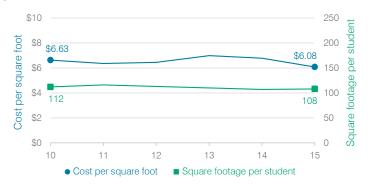
## Administrative cost per student



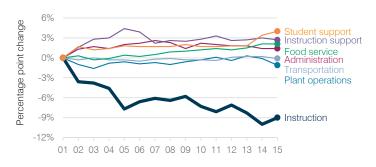
# Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)



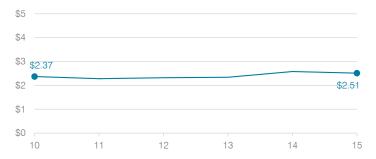
# Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student



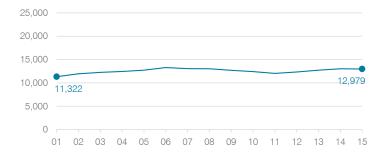
### Changes in operational spending percentages
