



Teacher Pay

• On average, each teacher earned \$3,883 in additional salary, and each librarian and counselor earned between \$3,889 and \$4,421.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Teachers were paid incentive monies for having two or fewer absences.
- Eligible employees earned \$250 per day plus expenses for attending 5-10 days of training on alignment with state standards, curriculum development, and alignment with International Baccalaureate standards.
- Mentor teachers received an incentive of \$200 per semester, and curriculum coordinators for math and reading received incentives of \$2,000 for the school year.
