



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher and librarian earned between \$3,084 and \$3,994 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Teachers each received \$500 if their school met Adequate Yearly Progress objectives.
- The District aimed to improve student achievement by reducing teacher absences.
 Teachers were paid incentive monies for having 1 or fewer absences.
- Eligible employees earned \$250 each day plus expenses for attending training on alignment with state standards and curriculum development.
- Teachers could also earn \$200 each semester for mentoring and tutoring at-risk students.

Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- 5 teachers were compensated for tutoring students struggling with the AIMS test.
