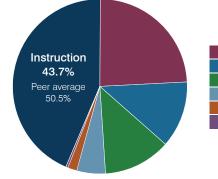

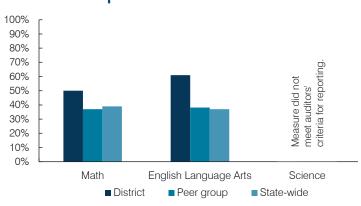

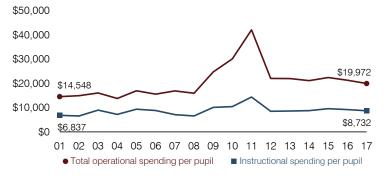

5-year spending trend (2012 through 2017)

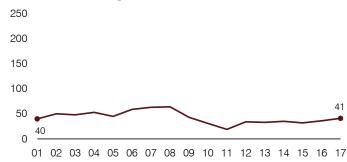
Administrative cost per pupil

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 10 percent. The percentage of dollars spent on instruction increased from 38.5 to 43.7 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, most noninstructional areas varied year to year, as is common for very small districts. Overall, administration and plant operations decreased substantially, while food service increased substantially.

Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2017 dollars)

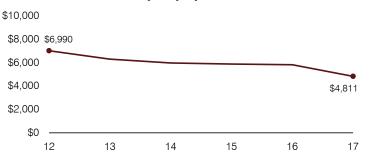

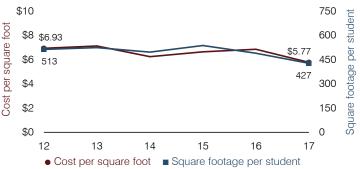

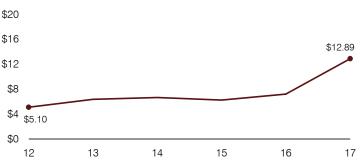
