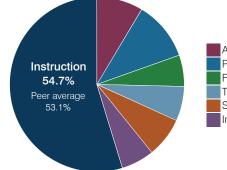

Spending by operational area



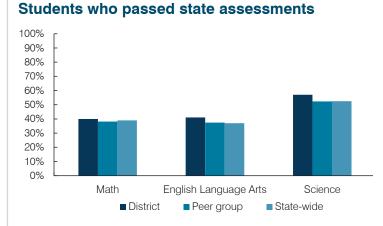

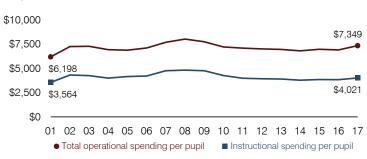
5-year spending trend (2012 through 2017)

Administrative cost per pupil

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 5 percent. The percentage of dollars spent on instruction decreased from 56 to 54.7 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, instruction support increased, while transportation decreased slightly. Most other noninstructional areas remained stable.

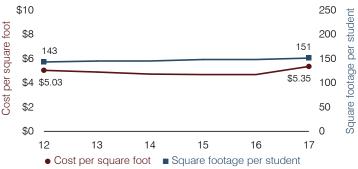
Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2017 dollars)



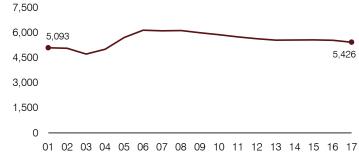

Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student



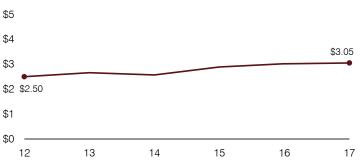

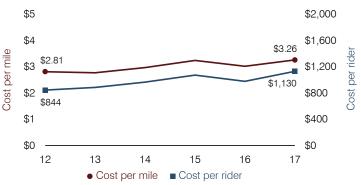
