



# District-reported 2008 results

### Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher and counselor earned \$6,312 in additional salary.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on individual performance.
- Student achievement goals were based on standardized test results.
- Teachers were compensated based on the percentage of students who achieved stated standards on performance tests.
- Teachers participated in a minimum of 15 hours of professional development activities including attending conferences and teaching workshops.

#### Menu

 Menu monies were used to increase eligible employee compensation, including paying for increased health insurance premiums.
