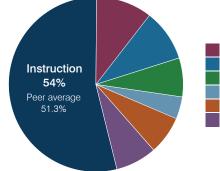

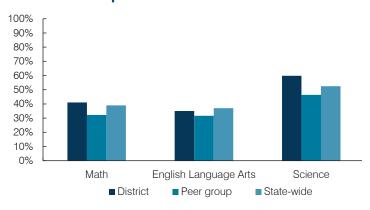

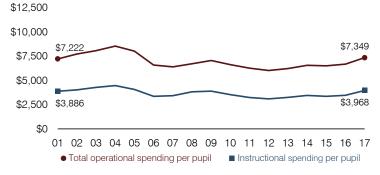

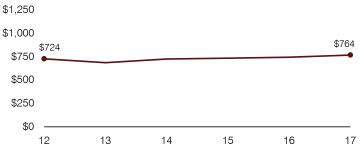
5-year spending trend (2012 through 2017)

Administrative cost per pupil

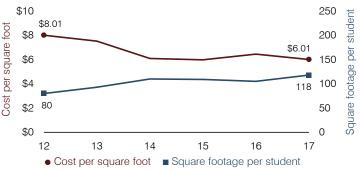
Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 22 percent. The percentage of dollars spent on instruction varied year to year, increasing overall from 51.4 to 54 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, administration decreased substantially and plant operations decreased, while instruction support increased and student support increased slightly.

Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2017 dollars)

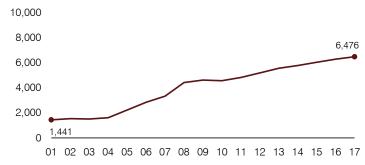




Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student

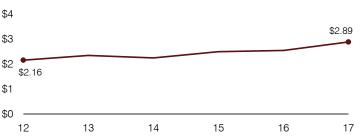

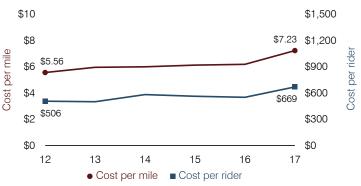
