



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, and counselor earned between \$5,435 and \$5,843 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- All schools received "Performing" or better labels from ADE for AZ LEARNS.
- Responses from a parent-student survey showed at least an 80 percent satisfaction rating for each school.
- Other goals focused on teacher evaluations, professional development, leadership, student management, and aligning lessons to state standards.

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase eligible employee compensation in an effort to attract and retain highly qualified staff.
- The District continued to use monies to provide teachers with reading strategies training.
