Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.42 percent of the District's $\$ 19,388,158$ current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional $\$ 2,400$ in compensation.
- The District had a school-wide performance plan with 10 performance indicators, which all schools met.
- Increased remedial help was provided to students at 4 elementary schools.
- At the middle school, a teacher was hired to mentor new teachers to improve student achievement. 60 percent of the District's teachers have been with the District 3 years or less.
