## District-reported 2003 results

## Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, and counselor earned between $\$ 2,528$ and \$3,560 in additional salary.


## Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district, school, and individual performance.
- Student performance on standardized tests, on average, met school goals.
- Teachers and other staff participated in 4 days of professonal development activities.
- More than 90 percent of teachers received acceptable performance evaluations.


## Menu

- Monies were used to reward teachers who accomplished professional development goals. Each teacher selected 5 goals from a list of 22 .
- A total of 438 goals were set, and 430 were accomplished.
