

Total spending per pupil decreased by 2 percent. Spending in the classroom decreased from 59 to 53.9 percent. Overall, spending on instruction support increased substantially, spending on food service increased, and spending on administration and transportation increased slightly. Spending on plant operations decreased slightly.






#### Administrative cost per student




# Total operational and instructional spending per student




## Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student




