



## District-reported 2003 results

### Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, counselor, librarian, speech pathologist, and audiologist earned between \$2,238 and \$3,238 in salary.

### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Goals were linked to student achievement, school ratings by ADE for AZ LEARNS, teacher evaluations, and a parent satisfaction survey. 2 schools accomplished 100 percent of goals; other schools accomplished between 75 and 92 percent of goals.

### Menu

- Monies were primarily used to pay for 3 days of professional development for all teachers, and for additional teacher compensation at 4 schools with performance programs based on individual performance and professional growth.
- Monies were also used for after-school study programs, including transportation and materials. 350 students received 30 hours of instruction to improve reading skills.
