

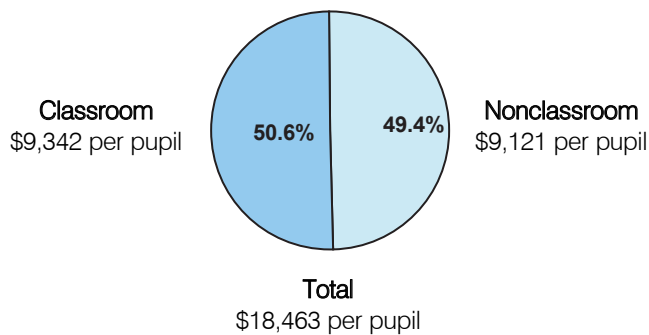

Fiscal year 2004

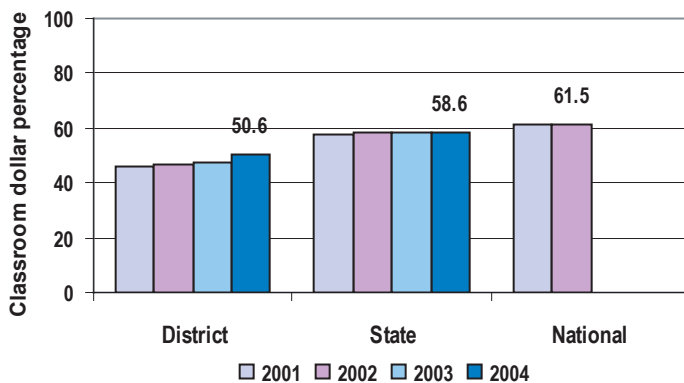

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2004 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional \$2,511 in salary, and the part-time counselor earned an additional \$715, which does not include a portion of performance pay distributed in fiscal year 2005.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Students' standardized test scores improved.
- Teachers completed professional development programs.
- Survey results indicated that parent and student satisfaction with the school increased.

##### Menu

- Monies were used solely to compensate teachers for participating in professional development activities that directly related to their grade and specialty.
