



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned between \$3,694 and \$4,305 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- 90 percent of 10th-grade students met standards on the AIMS test.
- The number of failing grades decreased each quarter.
- Students demonstrated writing skills through portfolios.
- All teachers completed at least 25 hours of professional development.
- Teachers also participated in student activities.
