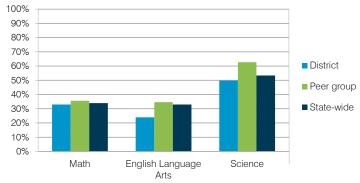

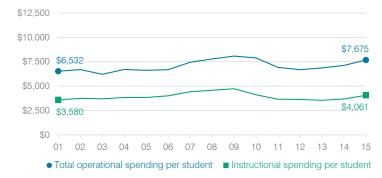

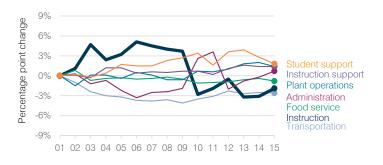
5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 3 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, increasing overall from 52 to 52.9 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, administration decreased, while plant operations, transportation, and instruction support increased slightly.

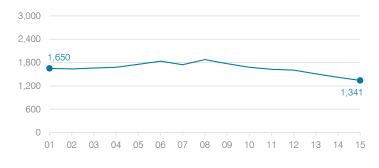
Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)



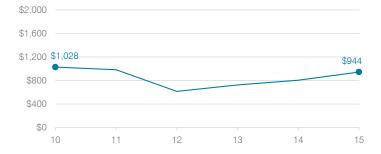
Changes in operational spending percentages



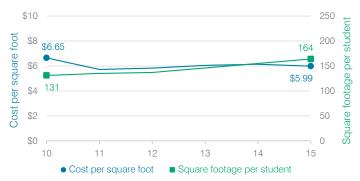

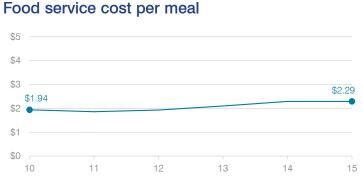


Administrative cost per student
