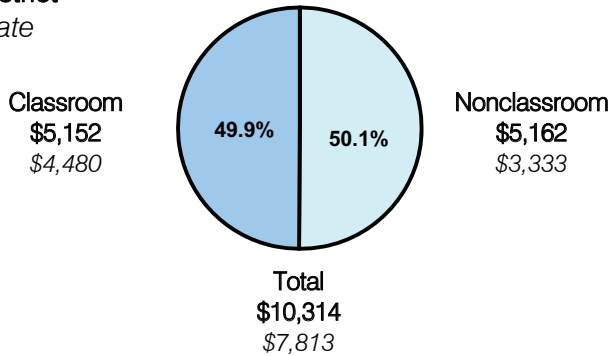

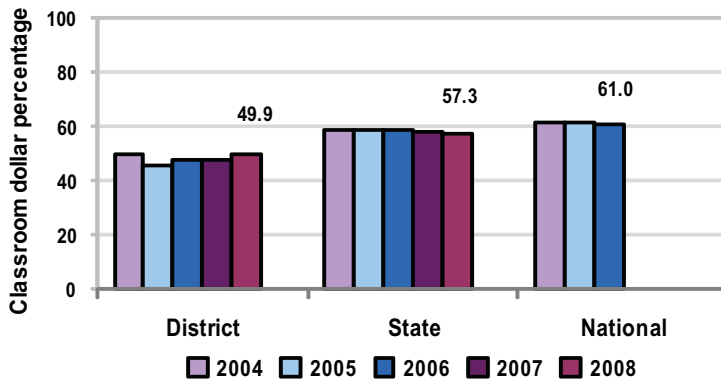

District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$6,153 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on individual and school performance.
- Students achieved 1 year's growth in the areas of reading and math as measured by pre- and post-tests.
- The District achieved at least an 80 percent parent-student satisfaction rating as measured by a school-wide survey.
- Teachers made a minimum of 8 parent contacts each grading period.
- Teachers achieved professional development goals from their individual teacher growth plans.

Menu

- Monies were used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- 8 teachers participated in 45 hours of training for Structured English Immersion certification.
