



## District-reported 2008 results

### Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, and counselor earned between \$5,159 and \$5,653 in additional salary, which includes performance pay for fiscal year 2007 performance.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- 2 of the District's 4 schools were labeled "Performing" by ADE for AZ LEARNS.
- Schools received positive ratings on parent satisfaction surveys.
- Most teachers participated in 4 parent activity nights.

#### Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Teachers participated in after-school AIMS intervention tutoring and summer school instruction.
