



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, and counselor earned between \$3,803 and \$4,449 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- Schools were labeled "Performing" or better by ADE for AZ LEARNS.
- Schools received positive ratings on parent satisfaction surveys.
- Most teachers participated in 4 parent activity nights.

Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Teachers participated in after-school AIMS intervention activities focused on improving reading scores. The District reports that students' AIMS scores have shown improvement.
