


Classroom Dollars

Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,984 in salary, and each speech pathologist and counselor earned between \$3,260 and \$3,960.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were ٠ similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school performance.
- 78 percent of students demonstrated 1 year's growth in reading and math on pre- and posttests.

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase teacher compensation for working up to 3 additional days and/or performing additional duties, such as strategic planning, language arts curriculum mapping, and mentoring other teachers.
- Menu monies continued to be used to pay for a 2nd-grade teacher to reduce that grade's class size from 33 to 25 students.
