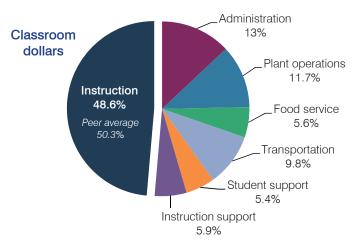

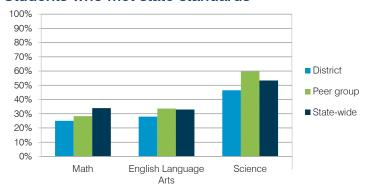

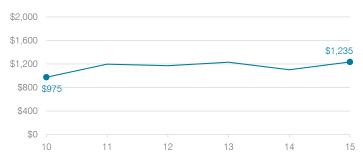

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 7 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, increasing overall from 47.1 to 48.6 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, plant operations and student support decreased, while administration increased. Transportation and instruction support varied year to year.

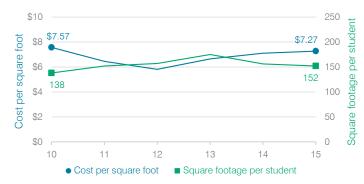
Administrative cost per student



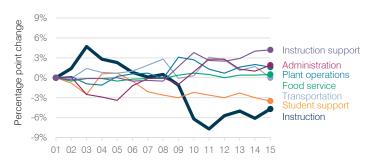
Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)



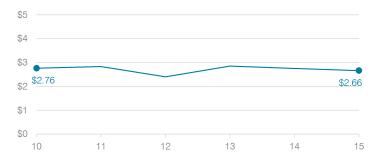
Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student



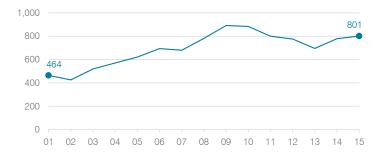
Changes in operational spending percentages
